CAP WIZ Alert....Posted July 5, 2011

The most recent CAP WIZ alert went to 3955 subscribers on July 5, 2011. So far we have had 49 **new** subscribers since alert went to a live posting and a reminder database emailed message was sent out. Please do not use your USDA email address or computer to send the messages, if you do, I will notify you with an email and the account will be inactivated by me...

723 subscribers have sent message and that means 2241 letters as of about 5:30 this morning. That is only 18.29% of subscribers! NASCOE has 7165 members so 55.88% are subscribed to CAP WIZ. If you want specific state numbers, let me know.

Listed below is the message sent using the national database records. If you are a member and did not receive this message from me, your state did not provide the National Membership Chair with your home email address for the database.

If you have questions or need assistance, please contact me. **Please only send the message once!** You may send through the take action on your CAP WIZ alert or through the website...just not both. It also sends to your state senators and house member based on zip code so it knows how many to send and to who.
